### Tuffin (Class 26)

#### Ingredients:

50g (2oz) sultanas  
75g (3oz) dates, chopped  
4 tablespoons rum  
200g (7oz) plain dark chocolate  
125g (4oz) butter  
150g (5oz) golden syrup  
250g (8oz) digestive biscuits, roughly crushed  
Rind of half orange, finely grated

#### Topping:

100g (3  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz) plain dark chocolate  
100g (3  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz) white chocolate  
50g (2oz) Maltesers, chopped

#### Method

1. Place sultanas, dates & rum in bowl and leave to soak for 30 mins.
2. Grease an 18 cm (7 inch) square cake tin and line the base.
3. Melt chocolate, butter and syrup in a pan.
4. Remove from heat and stir in the biscuits, orange rind and soaked fruit.
5. Turn the mixture into a tin and chill for 1 hour.
6. Melt the dark and white chocolate toppings in 2 separate bowls.
7. Pour the melted dark chocolate onto the biscuit base, then drizzle over the white chocolate. Make a swirled effect.
8. Sprinkle with the chopped Maltesers.
9. Leave to chill, then cut into wedges.
10. Serve 4 on a white paper plate.
