Tuffin (Class 26)

Ingredients:

50g (2oz) sultanas
 75g (3oz) dates, chopped
 4 tablespoons rum
 (7oz) plain dark chocolate
 125g (4oz) butter
 150g (5oz) golden syrup
 250g (8oz) digestive biscuits,
 roughly crushed rind of half orange, finely grated

Topping:

100g (3 ½ oz) plain dark chocolate
 100g (3 ½ oz) white chocolate
 50g (2oz) Maltesers, chopped 200g

Method

- Place sultanas, dates & rum in bowl and leave to soak for 30 mins.
- Grease an 18 cm (7 inch) square cake tin and line the base.
- Melt chocolate, butter and syrup in a pan.
- Remove from heat and stir in the biscuits, orange rind and soaked fruit.
- Turn the mixture into a tin and chill for 1 hour.
- Melt the dark and white chocolate toppings in 2 separate bowls.
- Pour the melted dark chocolate onto the biscuit base, then drizzle over the white chocolate. Make a swirled effect.
- Sprinkle with the chopped Maltesers.
- Leave to chill, then cut into wedges.
- Serve 4 on a white paper plate.
